## REGULATION OF VESSELS - EXCLUSION ZONE & SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

## Location

Lower Myall River – entire width of the river from Myall St Bridge, adjacent Tea Gardens to Tamboy village.

#### **Duration**

7:30am to 3:00pm - Saturday 21 September 2024.

## **Detail**

A number of competitive paddle craft events will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lower Myall River specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be monitored and indicated by the presence of control vessels stationed around the perimeter.

## **Transit lane**

Provision may be made (where necessary) for a control vessel to authorise local vessel traffic to pass safely through the Exclusion Zone via a 'transit lane'.

## **Special Restrictions**

Pursuant to section 12(3) of the Act, vessels using the transit lane must do so at a speed not exceeding 4 knots and must produce minimal wash.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - Marine Safety Act 1998).

A number of swim events will be conducted on the navigable waters of Fingal Bay, Port Stephens as specified above.


An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be marked by buoys and monitored and indicated by the presence of control vessels stationed around the boundary.

#### Location

The waters of Wollongong Harbour defined by:

- 1. the shoreline of Wollongong Harbour adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road, to
- 2. the eastern side of the remnants of the stone structure adjacent to the Wollongong Slipway, to
- 3. the entrance into the Wollongong Harbour from the Tasman Sea, to
- 4. the southern extent of the moored vessels, to
- 5. the shoreline of Wollongong Harbour adjacent to the intersection of Harbour Street and Cliff Road.

## **Duration**

On the following dates and times:

- 9:30am to 12:00pm Monday 23 September 2024.
- 9:30am to 12:00pm Tuesday 24 September 2024.

#### **Detail**

Various ocean swim events will be conducted within Belmore Basin, Wollongong Harbour as specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event which will be indicated by the presence of large inflatable buoys and monitored and maintained by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Detail

Vessel trials and exercises will be conducted on the navigable waters of Jervis Bay and the adjacent

coastal waters of the Tasman Sea at various times, including at night, on the dates specified above,

presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

EXCLUSION ZONES are specified during the trials and exercises which will be mobile and will

surround and move with participating vessels - in effect forming a moving ring around those

vessels.

The Exclusion Zones will be indicated by the presence of patrol and naval vessels on the perimeters.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zones.

# POINT TO POINT TRANSPORT (UBER PIN BOOKING TRIAL – T1 INTERNATIONAL TERMINAL, SYDNEY AIRPORT) EXEMPTION ORDER 2024

# Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017

I, Anthony Wing, NSW Point to Point Transport Commissioner, do pursuant to clause 92 of the *Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017* make the following Order.

# 1 Name of Order

This Order is the Point to Point Transport (UBER PIN Booking Trial – T1 International Terminal Sydney Airport) Exemption Order 2024.

# 2 Commencement

This Order commences on the date it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

# 3 Effect

This Order remains in force up to and including 20 September 2025 unless revoked earlier.

# 4 Interpretation

Words and expressions in this Order have the same meaning as in the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016 or the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017 unless otherwise stated.

Act means the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016.

**Driver** means a person who drives, or intends to drive, a hire vehicle that is being used to provide a passenger service.

**Hire vehicle** means a motor vehicle that is used to provide a passenger service that is not a taxi service.

Regulation means the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017.

**Uber** is the business name of the corporation registered as Rasier Pacific Pty Ltd (ACN 622 365 833) that is authorised under Part 3 of the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Act 2016 to provide a booking service.

**Uber PIN** means the booking system operated by Uber through which passengers are allocated a unique verification code after they have made a booking for a passenger service that matches them with a driver dispatched by Uber who has received a corresponding code from the booking system.

**Uber PIN Booking Trial** means the trial use of Uber PIN at T1 International Terminal, Sydney Airport and for the purposes of this order a Driver is considered to be participating in the Uber PIN Booking Trial from the time they log in to the Uber PIN booking system for the purpose of obtaining a booking to the time the passenger is dropped off to their destination.

# 5 Exemption

- **5.1** A Driver is exempt from the restriction under clause 84(a) of the Regulation, which states that the driver of a hire vehicle must not ply, stand or park the hire vehicle for hire on any road or road related area.
- **5.2** A Driver is exempt from the restriction under clause 84(b) of the Regulation, which states that the driver of a hire vehicle must not use the hire vehicle to carry out a hiring other than for a booking made before the driver stops the vehicle at the place where the passenger is picked up.

# 6 Condition

The exemptions in clause 5 of this Order only apply if the Driver is participating in the Uber PIN Booking Trial at T1 International Terminal, Sydney Airport.

**Note:** An exemption that is conditional ceases to have effect if the condition is not observed.

## **Explanatory note**

This object of this Order is to allow a trial of Uber PIN Booking technology in NSW, specifically at the T1 International Terminal at Sydney Airport.

Safety controls have been imposed as additional conditions on Uber's authorisation as a booking service provider to allow for the Uber Pin Booking Trial at the T1 International Terminal at Sydney Airport.

This Order is made under clause 92 of the Point to Point Transport (Taxis and Hire Vehicles) Regulation 2017.
