1. pursuant to section 20(2) of the Act, the qualifications and experience or additional standards or other requirements required to be held or met by the applicant for an endorsed contractor license; and
2. pursuant to section 25(2) of the Act, the qualifications and experience, or additional standards or other requirements, required to be held or met by an applicant for a qualified supervisor or tradesperson certificate

to be as follows:

- (a) where the application is received by the Secretary on or after the date on which this Instrument is signed (“the Commencement Date”):
  - (i) the possession of qualifications or the passing of examinations specified in Column 1 of Table A to Schedule 1; and
  - (ii) the possession of experience specified in Column 2 of Table A opposite the relevant matter in Column 1;
- (b) where the application is received by the Secretary before the Commencement Date of this Instrument:
  - (a) the possession of qualifications or the passing of examinations; and
  - (b) the possession of experience,

specified in the Instrument dealing with the same matters as this Instrument which was immediately in force at the time the relevant application was made.

## Explanatory note

As at the date of this Instrument, the Secretary, Department of Customer Service is the 'Secretary' under the Act. See the definition of "Secretary" in clause 1(1) of Schedule 1 of the Act.

## Interpretation

In this Instrument:

**"the Act"** means the Home Building Act 1989 (NSW);

**"Australian University"** has the same meaning as in the Higher Education Act 2001 (NSW) or successor legislation in force for the time being providing for the recognition of Australian universities;

references to **"Certificate"** and **"Licence"** are respectively to a qualified supervisor certificate, or endorsed contractor licence, as defined in the Act to do, or supervise general building work;

**"Degree"** means a degree of any kind, and in particular includes the degrees of doctor, master and bachelor but excludes an associate degree or honorary degree;

reference to a **"Diploma"** in Item 8 in Table D of Schedule 1, does not include a Diploma of: Building; Construction; Construction Management; Construction Economics; Applied Science (Building); Structural Engineering; or Quantity Surveying. On every other occasion the term "Diploma" is used in this Instrument it is to be given its ordinary meaning;

**"Experience"** means experience gained by the applicant as:

- (a) an employee of; or
- (b) a holder of a qualified supervisor certificate and as a nominated supervisor for the contractor licence held by; or
- (c) a holder of an endorsed contractor licence contracted to; or
- (d) a holder of a qualified supervisor certificate in the capacity of a nominated supervisor for a contractor licence held by an individual, partnership or corporation contracted to; or

the holder of a contractor licence authorising the holder to do the class of residential building work in which the experience was gained ("the Work"), where the applicant, during the relevant period, was:

supervised and directed in the doing of the Work by the holder of an endorsed contractor licence or qualified supervisor certificate authorising its holder to supervise the Work, and this is verified in the Relevant Application Form; and  
received Remuneration in accordance with law for the Work which the applicant carried out; or

- (e) a holder of a qualified supervisor certificate in the category of full general building work or an endorsed contractor licence in the category of full general building work, held continuously for a minimum period of 2 years within 10 years from the date the application is made;

**“Relevant Application Form”** means the relevant application form for the Licence or Certificate that is being applied for, which is published on the NSW Fair Trading website, including the required attachments to that form. (Note – Applications are to be made in accordance with section 12 of the Licensing and Registration (Uniform Procedures) Act 2002);

**“Registered Training Organisation”** has the same meaning as in the National Vocational Education and Training Regulator Act 2011 (Cth);

**“Residential building work”** has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 Clause 2 of the Act.

reference to **“Schedule 1”** includes the tables under Schedule 1 of this Instrument;

**“TAFE”** means the New South Wales Technical and Further Education Commission.

**“Remuneration”** means wages, salary and director’s fees paid to an applicant under a contract of employment and/or under a federal or state industrial agreement to provide services under which the person is employed on a regular basis but does not include bonuses, commissions, allowances or any other ad-hoc payments, including payments from a profit-sharing arrangement between the applicant and any another party, where such payments are the only payments made to the applicant for the work which the applicant carried out.

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**Exemption from provisions of the *Combat Sports Act 2013*  
Persons not ordinarily resident in Australia participating as trainers  
or seconds at UFC 312**

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The Combat Sports Authority of NSW (the “**Authority**”) exempts the specified class of persons described below from the requirement to be registered under section 20(1) of the *Combat Sports Act 2013* [NSW] (the “**Act**”) in the registration classes: *trainer-professional-mixed martial arts* and *second-professional-mixed martial arts*, subject to the conditions listed below, pursuant to section 102(1) of the Act.

**Specified class of persons**

Persons not ordinarily resident in Australia participating as trainers or seconds at the professional mixed martial arts contest to be held at Qudos Bank Arena, Sydney Olympic Park, NSW on 10 September 2023 (“**UFC 312**”), that do not satisfy the registration exemption provisions contained in clause 62(2) of the *Combat Sports Regulation 2014* [NSW].

**Conditions on this exemption**

This exemption is granted subject to the following conditions imposed pursuant to section 102(3) of the Act.

- (1) Persons subject to this exemption must provide to the Authority by 6pm on Friday 7 February 2025 evidence that satisfies the Authority of their identity.
- (2) Persons subject to this exemption must provide to the Authority by 6pm on Friday 7 February 2025 the name of each combatant that they will be assisting at UFC 312.
