MURDER

FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000) REWARD

On Tuesday 4 October 1988, William Anthony Rogers was shot dead whilst sitting in his taxi-cab at the intersection of Park Lane and Alma Street, Ashfield, NSW.

Notice is hereby given that a reward of up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) will be paid by the Government of New South Wales for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for murder of William Anthony Rogers.

The allocation of this reward will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Police.

The urgent assistance and co-operation of the public is especially sought in the matter. Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time of the day or night at any Police Station or by telephone -
