Ancillary Reports—In-service Failure of Explosion-protected Diesel Engine Systems Notice 2025

1. Name of notice

This notice is the *Ancillary Reports—In-service Failure of Explosion-protected Diesel Engine Systems Notice* 2025.

2. Commencement of notice

This notice takes effect on the day it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

3. Interpretation

Terms used in this notice have the same meaning as in the Work Health and Safety Act 2011, Work Health and Safety Regulation 2025, Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Act 2013 and the Regulation.

4. Replacement of 2022 notice

5. No ancillary report required for diesel engine explosion-protection failure at underground coal mine

(1) I specify that a diesel engine explosion-protection failure is not a class of incident that requires an ancillary report to be provided to the regulator under section 127 of the Regulation.

(2) In this section—

diesel engine explosion-protection failure means an incident referred to in the Regulation, section 124(5), definition of *high potential incident*, paragraph (i) to the extent that the incident relates to a diesel engine system.
