REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

**Location**

Lake Illawarra – extending from the shoreline of Burroo Point near the land-based locality of Skiway Park at Oak Flats.

**Duration**

- 6:00am to 4:30pm – Saturday 1 March 2025.

**Special Event**

Dragon boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Illawarra at the location specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, comprising of a square shape (approximately 250 metres by 250 metres), which will be indicated by the presence of buoys and monitored by control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the time above.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

**Location**

Clarence River, Corcoran Park - Western side of Elizabeth Island.

**Duration**

8:00am to 6:00pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 8 March 2025.
- Sunday 9 March 2025.

**Special Event**

Competitive power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Clarence River, Corcoran Park as specified above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, while will be indicated by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

**Location**

Lake Albert, Wagga Wagga – all navigable waters

**Duration**

8:00am to 5:30pm on the following dates:

- Saturday 22 February 2025.
- Sunday 23 February 2025.

**Special Event**

Power Boat Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Lake Albert as specified above. The event will involve the use of high speed power vessels, presenting a significant potential hazard to other waterway users.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event and will comprise the entirety of Lake Albert, which will effectively close the Lake to all other vessel use between the above times for this event.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone which will be monitored by event staff and support vessels.

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

**Location**

Tweed River and Rous River, Tumbulgam – Upstream of Dodds Island and approximately 500 metres upstream of the lower Rous River of the junction with Tweed River.

**Duration**

- Sunrise to Sunset – Tuesday 18 February 2025 to Monday 31 March 2025.

**Special Event**

A filming production event will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Tweed River and Rous River as specified above. The production involves numerous barges, support, safety vessels and work boats which will generally be operated at slow speeds.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will form a moving ring of 500 metres radius around the picture vessel 'Benedita'. The Exclusion Zone will be patrolled by NSW Police and Maritime vessels and monitored by event control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

**Location**

Farm Cove, Sydney Harbour.

**Special Event**

The Handa Opera event will take place at Farm Cove and will comprise a construction, performance, and deconstruction period as specified below.

**Duration**

The event as a whole will take place between 4:00pm Monday 24 February 2025 to 6:00pm Sunday 4 May 2025, and will comprise the following periods :

- Between 4:00pm Monday 24 February 2025 and 12:00pm Wednesday 19 March 2025 – 24 hours per day (Construction).
- Between 6:30pm Wednesday 19 March 2025 and 11:00pm Sunday 20 April 2025 – 6:30pm to 11:30pm per day (Performance).
- Between 6:00am Monday 21 April 2025 and 6:00pm Sunday 4 May 2025 – 6:00am to 11:00pm per day (Deconstruction).

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the times listed at the above location. Each period will have a different Exclusion Zone which will be indicated by lit yellow buoys and monitored and patrolled by the presence of control and security vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.
