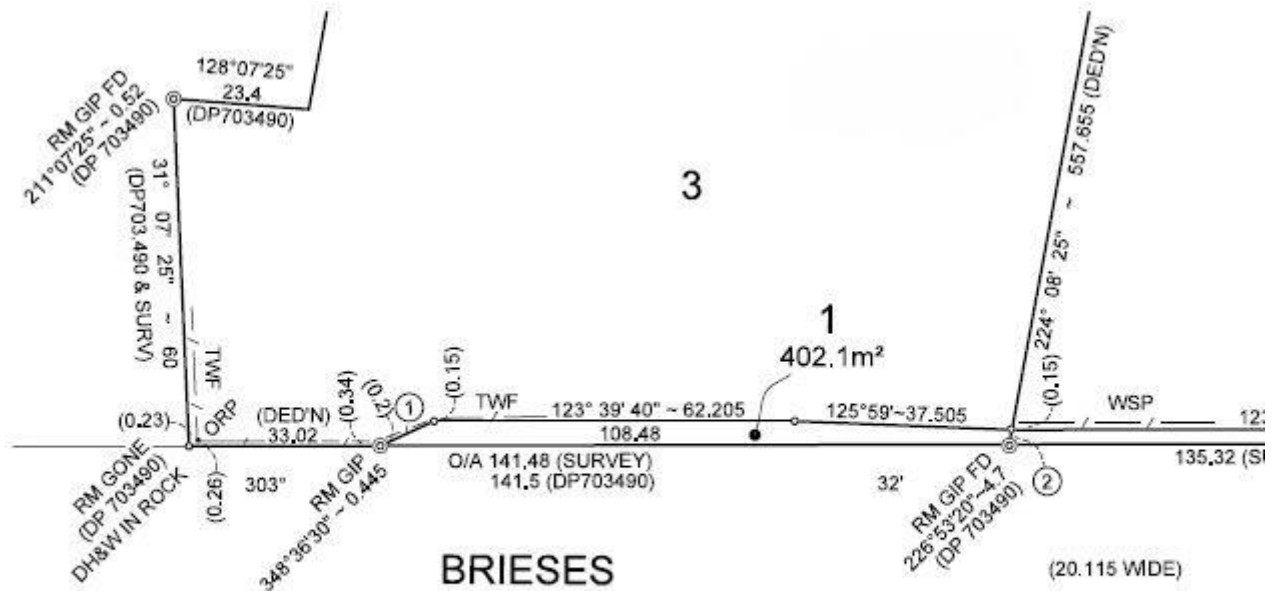

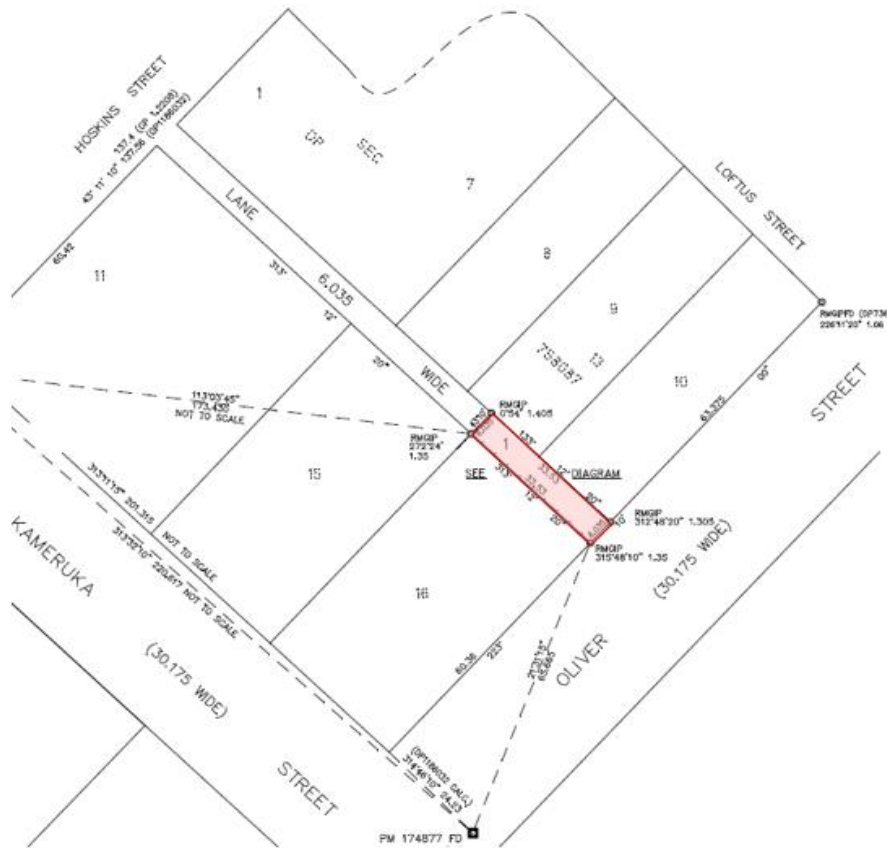

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Location

Cudgen Creek, Kingscliff – between Cudgen Foreshore Park and the Cudgen Creek Breakwalls.

Duration

- 5:00am to 11:00am - Sunday 23 March 2025.

Special Event

A swimming event will be conducted on the navigable waters of Cudgen Creek specified above.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by buoys and monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (Section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)

MARINE NOTICE

Section 12(2)

REGULATION OF VESSELS – EXCLUSION ZONE

Revocation

This Marine Notice revokes and replaces Notice NH2528, published in Government Gazette No 67 of 21 February 2025, relating to a filming production event between 18 February 2025 and 31 March 2025.

Location

Tweed River and Rous River, Upstream of Dodds Island and approximately 500 metres upstream of the lower Rous River of the junction with Tweed River Tumbulgum.

Duration

2:00am to 9:00pm on the following dates:

- Friday 7 March 2025 to Sunday 30 March 2025.

Special Event

A filming production event will be conducted on the navigable waters of the Tweed River and Rous River as specified above. The production involves numerous barges, support, safety vessels and work boats which will generally be operated at slow speeds.

An **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will form a moving ring of 500 metres radius around the picture vessel 'Benedita'. The Exclusion Zone will be patrolled by NSW Police and Maritime vessels and monitored by event control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (section 12(5) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*)
