MARINE NOTICE

PROHIBITION OR REGULATION OF VESSELS AND PERSONS IN WATERS

Marine Safety Act 1998
Section 18B

Location

Ulladulla Harbour and the Tasman Sea, Ulladulla - All navigable waters within a 150m radius of the northern breakwall of Ulladulla Harbour.

Duration

- 6:00pm to 10:00pm – Sunday 20 April 2025.

Activity or Event

A fireworks show will be conducted over the navigable waters of the Ulladulla Harbour and the Tasman Sea as specified above. The waterway directly around the firing location may be dangerous and hazardous to waterway users.

Exclusion Zone

Pursuant to Section 18B(2)(a), an **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will extend 150m around the display and will be monitored by control vessels.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (Section 18B(4) - *Marine Safety Act 1998*).
