ACTS OF PARLIAMENT ASSENTED TO Legislative Assembly Office, 11 June 2025

It is hereby notified, for general information, that Her Excellency the Governor, has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, this day assented to the under mentioned Acts passed by the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, viz.:

Act No. 27 — An Act to amend the *Children (Detention Centres) Act 1987*, the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999* and the *Mental Health and Cognitive Impairment Forensic Provisions Act 2020* to require agencies responsible for administering victims registers to notify victims of certain offenders of the existence of the registers and the victim's eligibility to be registered; and to amend the *Victims Rights and Support Act 2013* to allow particular personal and health information to be shared between government agencies for keeping victims informed of particular matters. **[Victims Legislation Amendment (Victims Registers) Bill]**

Act No. 28 — An Act to amend the *Bail Act 2013* to prohibit the practice of accused persons granted bail being monitored by private providers as a condition of bail; to make related amendments to the *Bail Act 2013*; and to make consequential amendments to the *Bail Regulation 2021*. **[Bail Amendment (Ban on Private Electronic Monitoring) Bill]**

Act No. 29 — An Act to amend the *Electoral Funding Act 2018* to make further provision in relation to payments from the Administration Fund; and for related matters. **[Electoral Funding Amendment Bill]**

Act No. 30 — An Act to make miscellaneous amendments to legislation relating to health and associated matters. **[Health Legislation Amendment (Miscellaneous) Bill]**

Act No. 31 — An Act to adopt certain provisions of the *Help to Buy Act 2024* of the Commonwealth, to refer matters relating to amendments to that Act to the Parliament of the Commonwealth for the purposes of section 51(xxxvii) of the Commonwealth Constitution, to make consequential amendments to other Acts; and for other purposes. **[Help to Buy (Commonwealth Powers) Bill]**

Act No. 32 — An Act to amend the *Cemeteries and Crematoria Act 2013* to make further provision about the management and operations of cemeteries and crematoria; and for other purposes. **[Cemeteries and Crematoria Amendment Bill]**

Act No. 33 — An Act to amend the *Health Services Act 1997* to prohibit new public-private partnership arrangements for the provision of acute hospitals and services; and for related purposes. **[Health Services Amendment (PPP Prohibition) Bill]**
