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MARINE NOTICE

REGULATION OF VESSELS – RESTRICTION OF SPEED OF VESSELS

Marine Safety Act 1998 Section 11(1)

Location

Statewide – all navigable waters of NSW.

Duration

• From 1 July 2025 to 12:00 midnight 30 April 2026.

Regulation

Pursuant to section 11(2A)(a) and 11(3)(c) of the *Marine Safety Act 1998*, a **maximum speed restriction of 60 knots** (approximately 110 kilometres per hour) is temporarily imposed on all powered vessels towing any person of any age, in NSW navigable waters.

Penalties may apply (section 11(4) - Marine Safety Act 1998.

This Notice does not derogate from any local waterway restriction on the towing of persons where a lower speed limit has been set, and any such local limit continues to apply.

Explanatory Note

For the safety of the public, Transport for NSW as delegate of the Minister has determined to limit the speed of any vessel towing any person in NSW navigable waters to 60 knots pending review of the waterway traffic arrangements for the State, in particular concerning the safety of persons involved in watersport activities.

Clause 46 of the *Marine Safety Regulation 2016* limits the speed of any vessel towing a person under the age of 18 to 60 knots. By this Notice, that regulation is effectively extended to cover any person of any age being towed.



Declaration as Freeway of part of the Hunter Expressway at Buchanan and Seahampton

I, the Minister for Roads, by this order pursuant to Sections 46, 48, 54 and 67 of the Roads Act, 1993:

MINISTERIAL ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 19

Ministerial (Electric and Hydrogen Vehicle Transit Lane Exemption) Order 2025

I, Jenny Aitchison, Minister for Roads, pursuant to section 19(1) of the *Road Transport Act* 2013 (NSW), make the following Order.

1. Name of Order

This Order is the *Ministerial (Electric and Hydrogen Vehicles Transit Lane Exemption) Order 2025.*

2. Commencement

This Order has effect on and from 1 July 2025 and remains in force up to and including 30 June 2027 unless revoked earlier.

3. Interpretation

Words and expressions used in this Order have the same meaning as in the *Road Transport Act 2013* unless otherwise stated.

4. Definitions

In this Order the following are defined:

battery electric vehicle means a motor vehicle that—

- (a) uses only an electric motor for propulsion, and
- (b) is not fitted with-
 - (i) a fuel cell, or
 - (ii) an internal combustion engine.

hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicle means a motor vehicle that—

- (a) uses an electric motor for propulsion, and
- (b) is equipped with a fuel cell for converting hydrogen to electricity, and
- (c) is not fitted with an internal combustion engine.

5. Circumstances

This Order only applies to a driver of a *battery electric vehicle* or *hydrogen fuel cell electric vehicle* to which is affixed to the vehicle's number plate a label in accordance with clauses 144A or 144B of Schedule 2 of the Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2017.

6. Declaration

Road Rule 156 of the Road Rules 2014 is declared not to apply to drivers meeting the circumstances outlined in clause 5 of the Order.

7. Publication

The Order is to be published in the NSW Government Gazette.

Explanatory note:

The object of this Order is to allow drivers of battery electric and hydrogen fuel cell motor vehicles to be driven in Transit Lanes, regardless of the number of passengers in the vehicle, subject to meeting certain circumstances in the Order.

This Order is made under section 19 of the Road Transport Act 2013.
