MARINE NOTICE

PROHIBITION OR REGULATION OF VESSELS AND PERSONS IN WATERS

Marine Safety Act 1998 Section 18B

Location

Hunter River, Raymond Terrace – entire width of the river downstream from the Fitzgerald Bridge, between the prolongations of Bourke Street and Swan Street.

Duration

8.30am to 5.30pm on the following dates:

- Sunday, 13 July 2025.
- Sunday, 17 August 2025.

Activity or Event

A number of high-speed powerboat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Hunter River, Raymond Terrace as specified above.

Exclusion Zone

Pursuant to Section 18B(2)(a), an **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will be indicated by control vessels stationed on the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Transit Lane

A 'Transit Lane' may be established (where necessary), within which a control vessel may, at times during the event, permit local vessel traffic to pass through the Exclusion Zone. At such times, the Exclusion Zone will not be enforced.

Special Restrictions

Pursuant to Section 18B(2)(b), **SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS** are applicable as follows to vessels operating in the vicinity of the Exclusion Zone:

- Maximum speed limit of 4 knots, and
- Minimal wash must be produced.

Penalties may apply (Section 18B(4) - Marine Safety Act 1998).

Activity or Event

High-speed power boat races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Main Beach, South West Rocks as specified above.

Exclusion Zone

Pursuant to Section 18B(2)(a), an **EXCLUSION ZONE** is specified during the event, which will comprise the area set out in the attached map and marked in the bright yellow outline. The Exclusion Zone will be marked by buoys and monitored by control vessels stationed around the boundary.

Unauthorised vessels and persons are strictly prohibited from entering the Exclusion Zone during the times above.

Penalties may apply (Section 18B(4) - Marine Safety Act 1998).
