REGULATION 2017**

(Clause 22(a))

Order determining application fee for container approvals

I, Alexandra Geddes, Acting Chief Executive Officer of the NSW Environment Protection Authority (**EPA**), on behalf of the EPA and by this Order:

Revocation

1. Revoke the Order issued under clause 22(a) of the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery (Container Deposit Scheme) Regulation 2017 (**Regulation**) dated 24 September 2020 and published in the NSW Government Gazette No 232 of 25 September 2020.

Application Fee

2. Determine that the application fee for a container approval under clause 22(a) of the Regulation is nil or \$0 (zero) dollars, notwithstanding that the EPA may require a fee to accompany an application for a container approval.

This Order commences on the date it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

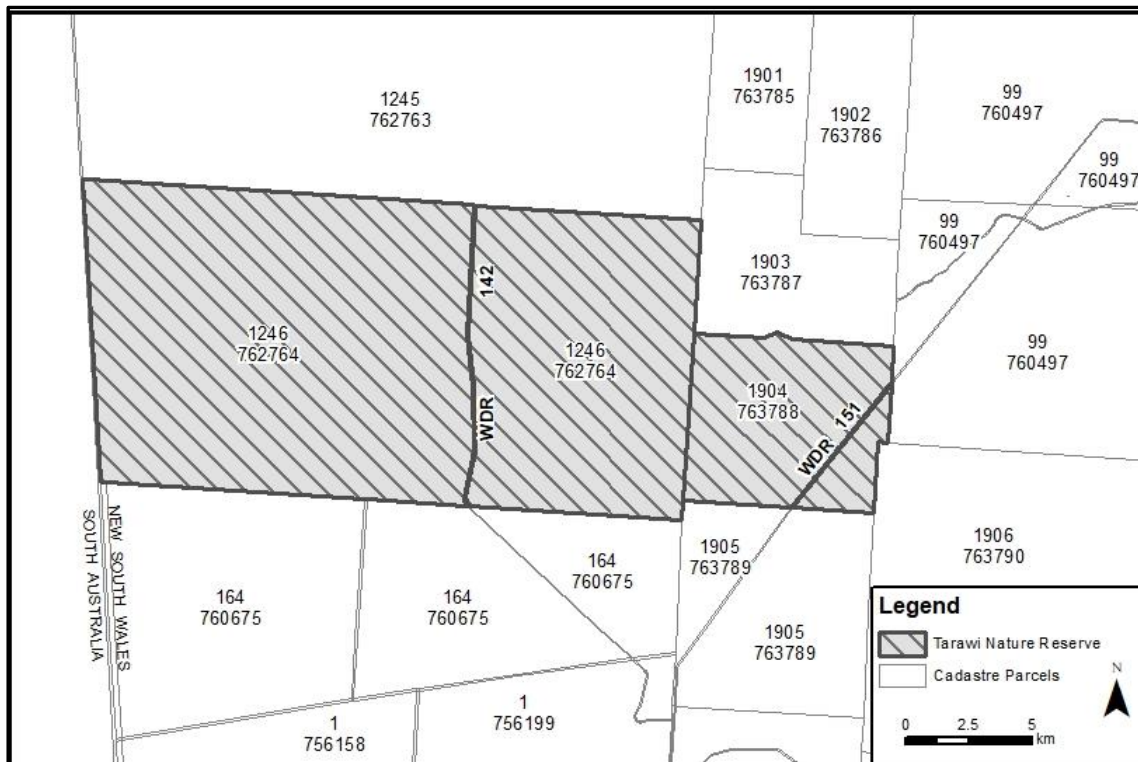

ERRATUM

In the notice published in the NSW Government Gazette dated 4 April 1996, folios 1651 and 1652 reserving land as Tarawi Nature Reserve, the Description is replaced by

County Tara about 33,463 hectares being Lot 1246 DP762764 and Lot 1904 DP763788, exclusive of Tarawi Road (WDR 142) and Springwood Road (WDR 151), being a strip 60 metres wide (30 metres either side of the centreline of the road formation) as shown by hatching in the diagram below.
