Standards for Breathing Apparatus to Assist Escape (Including Self-Rescuers) Order 2025

I, **Anthony Margetts**, Chief Inspector, with the delegated authority of the Secretary, Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development, under section 187(5) of the *Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2022*, make the following Order.

Part 1—Preliminary

1. Name of Order

This Order is the Standards for Breathing Apparatus to Assist Escape (Including Self-Rescuers) Order 2025.

2. Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the NSW Government Gazette.

3. Interpretation

(1) In this Order—

AS ISO/IEC 17025:2018 means the Australian standard named AS ISO/IEC 17025:2018 - General requirements for the competence of testing and calibration laboratories, published by Standards Australia.

AS/NZS 1716:2012 means the Australian and New Zealand standard named AS/NZS 1716:2012 *Respiratory protective devices*, published jointly by Standards Australia and Standards New Zealand.

AS/NZS ISO/IEC 17020:2013 means the Australian and New Zealand standard named AS/NZS ISO/IEC 17020:2013 – Conformity assessment – Requirements for the operation of various types of bodies performing inspection, published jointly by Standards Australia and Standards New Zealand.

breathing apparatus means breathing apparatus to assist escape (including self-rescuers) used in underground coal mines.

WHS laws has the same meaning as in the Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Act 2013.

- WHS Regulations has the same meaning as in the Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Act 2013.
- (2) Unless otherwise stated—words and expressions that are defined in the WHS laws have the same meaning in this Order

4. Revocation

The Registration of Breathing Apparatus to Assist Escape (including Self-Rescuers) Design Order 2022 (No.4) published in the NSW Government Gazette No.561 of 2 December 2022 is revoked.

Part 2—Standards for registration—plant design

5. Standards for registration—general

- (1) For the purposes of the *Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites)* Regulation 2022, section 187(5), the design of breathing apparatus must meet the standards specified in this clause.
- (2) The design of breathing apparatus must meet 1 of the following—
 - (a) the requirements specified in AS/NZS 1716:2012, or
 - (b) to the extent that the design does not meet the requirements specified in AS/NZS 1716:2012—having regard to the hierarchy of control measures, an equivalent level of safety as the requirements of AS/NZS 1716:2012.
- (3) The design of breathing apparatus must be performance tested—
 - (a) in accordance with AS/NZS 1716:2012, and
 - (b) in a test facility which is independent of the designer, manufacturer or supplier of the breathing apparatus that is—
 - (i) accredited by the National Association of Testing Authorities (NATA) for the testing of breathing apparatus, or
 - (ii) if demonstrated to the regulator that a test facility mentioned in subparagraph (i) is not available, a test facility that
 - A. is accredited by an organisation that is a signatory to the International Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation Mutual Recognition Arrangement (ILAC MRA) for the testing of breathing apparatus, or
 - B. meets the requirements of AS ISO/IEC 17025:2018 and has been independently audited in accordance with the requirements of AS/NZS ISO/IEC 17020:2013 within the last 2 years.
- (4) If the design of breathing apparatus meets the standard specified in subclause (2)(b), the designer must specify the published technical standards or engineering principles used to design the plant.
- (5) In this clause—

hierarchy of control measures means the hierarchy of control measures specified under the WHS Regulations, Part 3.1, clause 36.

Note—The design of breathing apparatus cannot be registered under the WHS Regulations, Part 5.3 if it does not comply with these standards—see the *Work Health and Safety (Mines and Petroleum Sites) Regulation 2022*, section 187(6).

Part 3—Alteration of design after registration

6. Alterations to registration

- (1) This clause applies if—
 - (a) a design is altered after it is registered under the WHS Regulations, Part 5.3, and
 - (b) the alteration may affect health and safety.
- (2) The alteration must meet the standards for registration specified in clause 5.
- (3) The designer must undertake and document an assessment of the impact of the design alteration on unaltered parts of the breathing apparatus.
- (4) To avoid doubt, a part of the breathing apparatus which is not affected by the alteration must continue to comply with the design requirements of the design order that was in effect on the date that the registration for the design of the breathing apparatus was granted.
