Major Events (Israeli Presidential Visit) Order 2026

Major Events (Israeli Presidential Visit) Order 2026

under the

Major Events Act 2009

1 Name of order

This order is the *Major Events (Israeli Presidential Visit) Order 2026*.

2 Commencement

This order commences on the day on which this order is published in the Gazette.

3 Definitions

In this order—

declared major event means the Israeli Presidential Visit, being an event that is the subject of a major event declaration by the *Major Events Regulation 2025*.

Israeli Presidential Visit means the Australian Government's Guest of Government visit by the Israeli President, Isaac Herzog, and other Israeli dignitaries, in the aftermath of the 14 December 2025 Bondi terrorist attack.

Israeli Presidential Visit area means the land on the map set out in Schedule 1.

major event period—see section 5.

the Act means the *Major Events Act 2009*.

Note—The Act and the *Interpretation Act 1987* contain definitions and other provisions that affect the interpretation and application of this order.

4 Declaration of major event area

For the Act, section 4B(1), the Israeli Presidential Visit area is declared to be the major event area for the declared major event.

5 Meaning of “major event period”

For the Act, section 5A(1)(a), the period commencing at the beginning of 9 February 2026 and ending at the end of 12 February 2026 is specified as the **major event period** for the declared major event.

6 Application of provisions of the Act, Part 4

For the Act, sections 5A(1)(b) and 13, the following provisions of the Act, Part 4 apply in relation the declared major event for the whole of the major event period—

- (a) Division 5, other than section 47,
- (b) sections 61 and 62.
