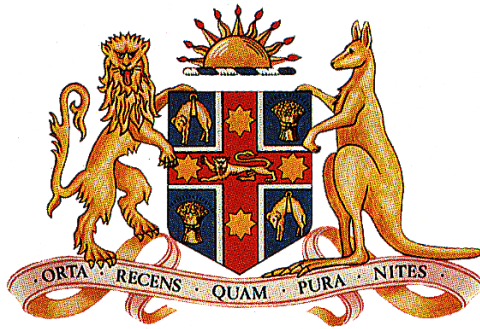

Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011

Order under section 20

- (1) pursuant to sections 20(1) of the *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011* by this Order, authorise the fittings described in Schedule 1 to be, on and from the date on which this Order is published in the *New South Wales Government Gazette*, authorised fittings to be used for plumbing and drainage work for the purposes of Section 8 of the *Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011*.

Schedule 1

Authorised fittings to be used for plumbing and drainage

1. HYDRALOOP

A fitting that -

- (a) is defined by NSW Health as a Greywater Processing Device (GPD)
- (b) is manufactured in the Netherlands by Hydraloop BV; and
- (c) receives wastewater from a shower, bath and/or washing machine, and uses physical separation, biological treatment, and disinfection with UV light to produce greywater suitable for household re-use;

The fitting can be used for Plumbing and Drainage work under the following factors-

- (a) only installed as part of a trial initiated by Sydney Water Corporation on the effects of water re-use and conservation, until the fitting meets the evidence of suitability outlined in Part A5 of the Plumbing Code of Australia; and
- (b) the Sydney Water Corporation shall advise the plumbing regulator the address or addresses where the fitting is installed; and
- (c) any pressurised greywater pipe work connected on the outlet of the fitting shall have a recycled water rough in type inspection arranged in accordance with s.13(1) of the Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011; and
- (d) on the initial commissioning of the fitting a recycled water final inspection shall be arranged in accordance with s.13(1) of the Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011; and
- (e) the fitting is installed in compliance with any requirements under Local Government Act 1993; and
- (f) the fitting manufacturers installation instructions are adhered to including future servicing requirements; and
- (g) any faults identified associated with the fitting that pose an imminent threat to public health are to be advised to the plumbing regulator in accordance with s. 11(2) of the Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011; and
- (h) at the completion of the trial period determined by Sydney Water Corporation, should the fitting not meet the evidence of suitability outlined in Part A5 of the Plumbing Code of Australia, the fitting shall be disconnected and removed from use.

2. WATER PRESSURE PUMPS

A fitting that -

- (a) is used in a cold water or heated water service; and
- (b) is used to raise water pressure or circulate water in a system

The fitting can be used for Plumbing and Drainage work under the following factors-

- (a) associated components within the fitting that are in contact with cold water or heated water require evidence of suitability in the form of a current certificate issued by a certification body stating that the properties and performance of the fitting can meet the requirements of Part A5G4 (1) of the Plumbing Code Australia.

3. WET WELLS AND PRESSURE SEWER PUMPS

A fitting that -

- (a) is used to collect sewage or wastewater from a sanitary drainage system or sanitary plumbing system; and
- (b) is fitted with a pumping device to raise contents to a suitable disposal point

The fitting can be used for Plumbing and Drainage work under the following factors-

- (a) where used to pump to a Network Utility Operator pressure sewer infrastructure, the fitting must be tested and meet the requirements of WSA 07:2007; or
- (b) where used to pump to a sanitary plumbing system or sanitary drainage system, the fitting requires evidence of suitability in the form of a current certificate issued by a certification body stating that the properties and performance of the fitting can meet the requirements of the Plumbing Code of Australia.

4. BIDET DOUCHE SEATS WITH INTEGRAL WATER HEATER

A fitting that -

- (a) is a sanitary fixture equipped with a douche device for producing a jet of water for the purposes of personal hygiene; and
- (b) is fitted to a water closet (WC) pan; and
- (c) has an integral water heater capable of producing heated water for use during operation of the fitting;

The fitting can be used for Plumbing and Drainage work under the following factors-

- (a) the fitting must meet Parts A5G4 (1) of the Plumbing Code Australia; and
- (b) where the fitting has an integral water heater for hygiene purposes:
 - a. the fitting must meet Schedule 5 NSW B2D5 of the Plumbing Code of Australia; and
 - b. the fitting must have evidence of suitability in the form of a current certificate issued by a certification body stating that the properties and performance of the fitting can meet the requirements of Clauses 11.8 and 19 of IEC 60335-2-84 or AS/NZS 60335-2-84

5. SENSOR TAP WITH INTEGRAL WATER HEATER

A fitting that -

- (a) is a sensor tap to provide hands free activation for the purposes of personal hygiene; and
- (b) is fitted to a basin; and
- (c) is a Caroma HeatStream

Can be used for Plumbing and Drainage work under the following factors-

- (a) only installed as part of a trial initiated by GWA Group Limited for the technology to be performance validated in a commercial environment, until the fitting meets the evidence of suitability outlined in Part A5 of the Plumbing Code of Australia; and
- (b) the trial is to be completed at 24 York Street, Sydney, NSW, 2000; and
- (c) where the fitting has an integral water heater for hygiene purposes the fitting must meet Schedule 5 NSW B2D5 of the Plumbing Code of Australia; and
- (d) any faults identified associated with the fitting that pose an imminent threat to public health are to be advised to the plumbing regulator in accordance with s. 11(2) of the Plumbing and Drainage Act 2011; and
- (e) at the completion of the trial period should the fitting not meet the evidence of suitability outlined in Part A5 of the Plumbing Code of Australia, the fitting shall be disconnected and removed from use.
